Education

The NSW Department of Education plays a pivotal role in the delivery and co-ordination of early childhood, primary school, secondary school, vocational education, adult, migrant, and higher education amongst New South Wales.

The NSW Department of Education aims to continuously improve education and the career outcomes for young people across all industry sectors.

In 2020, The NSW Department of Education launched the Educational Pathways Pilot Program (EPPP). The EPPP is a beneficial program for all students as it centres around supporting students in school-based apprenticeships and traineeships through mentoring, engaging students in fee-free VET Smart & Skilled programs along with other resources to strengthen students' job ready skills.

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MWLP - Linking Youth is a not-for-profit organisation, specialising as a Work Placement Host provider, located in Campbelltown. MWLP's primary focus is the placement of 6,500 Work Placement Students with local businesses within the Macarthur, Greater Bankstown Region, and beyond!

MWLP not only facilitates Work Placement, but various other career development activities. Other MWLP services include:

- **Work Readiness Talks:** Work Readiness Talks are designed to prepare students for their week-long placement with their host employer. MWLP covers various topics including employer expectations, appropriate dress attire and safety in the workplace.
- **Jobs For Youth Nights:** MWLP's Jobs For Youth Nights aim to create a space for the youth to connect and engage with potential employers, apprenticeship and traineeship opportunities and other career development opportunities. - **Student Hubs:** MWLP have run two student-led social enterprise initiatives which were designed to positively impact the lives of disadvantaged community members whilst simultaneously engaging the youth.
